Introduction

In addition to regular show dates, Michael Gabriel is spreading awareness about children living in developing countries and the message in his music through performances booked for this specific cause

Presentation Outline

His presentation (30- 45 minutes) involves:

- a brief introduction
- performing a few original songs
- discussion about the message in the music
- speaking about children living in developing countries
- one theme related song about children who are; through circumstance, taking on parental roles at a very young age
- a 5 minute DVD clip illustrating the lifestyle lived by two children whose parents have died of aids (suitable for grades 1 and up)
- Michael’s experience as a musician
- ‘Question and Answer’ period

Organizing a Booking

Each booking and presentation is unique to the location and is planned with the organizers of the event. School visits have an emphasis on both:

1) The message of Michael’s music:

- Follow your heart
- Be a good person
- Never give up
- Be who you are

2) The reality facing children and adults all over the world:

Michael performs an original song called: 7 Going On 24. The song was premiered with The Riverdale Community Choir in 2004 during a benefit for Africa in Toronto, Ontario.

Michael Gabriel works with the World Vision Artist Associate Program. As mentioned above, a short DVD from World Vision is also an option.
